A POLAR DREAM

In the heart of the Arctic Ocean, at 76-81° North, the Svalbard Archipelago remains one of the worlds last great 'firsts'. Despite numerous attempts, no one has ever paddled around all four main islands.

After 6 years of dreaming and planning to complete this trip, this coming summer we are setting off to do just that.



THE PLAN

In late June 2015, our team will fly north to Longyearbyen, Svalbard, to begin our 2000-kilometre sea kayak journey around the archipelago. We expect this adventure to take around 90 days, and apart from two planned food drops, we will be paddling expedition style without a support crew.

Our strategy for this expedition will depend on our predictions for the ice break up around the north-east corner of the archipelago. Some of the major challenges that we will face include a 300 kilometre uninterrupted stretch of glacial cliffs, polar bears, walrus, freezing temperatures and pack ice.





After years of dreaming and planning, our crew has at last come together. We are an international team combining a mix of solid technical kayak expedition and cold enviroment skills, and united by a simple love of adventure. Our team consists of New Zealanders Jaime Sharp (33) and Tara Mulvany (25), Jeff Allen from the UK, and Per Gustav Porsanger (PG) from Norway. Between us, we have travelled thousands of miles in sea kayaks, worked in the challenging enviroments of the far north and deep south, and have completed circumnavigations of Japan, South Georgia, Ireland, Vancouver Island and the three main islands of New Zealand.



PADDLE NORTH WITH US


